MOU/Scholarship between the Jude House and CSM

The Jude House has been working with CSM to develop an MOU for a Scholarship program for the clients at the Jude House. Once the MOU was developed there was a need for funding. A letter was sent to SMWL asking to kick off the scholarship by funding it with \$5,000.

As the two-year grant recipient, and as a final request, SMWL was asked to establish **The Jude House Recovery Annual Scholarship** with the **College of Southern Maryland Foundation**. This Scholarship will be for the sole purpose of providing financial assistance to current clients utilizing recovery services provided by the Jude House. This will afford clients assistance for tuition, books, fees, and other related items.

The Scholarship funds can provide a GED, classes to obtain a skill, or the start of an educational path. It is not enough to be drug free; people need a purpose and a skill to make them successful.

This scholarship would not have been possible without the generous \$5,000.00 grant provided by our League to start this program. In the future, the Jude house will seek funds from other organizations to help keep this scholarship in affect.

SMWL should be very proud of this program. There was a ceremony at CSM for the signing of the MOU, and the presentation of the check. A press release and photo will be coming in the next week and will be provided to SMWL for their website and to share with the members. You have no idea how much this program can mean to someone in a recovery program, just to know there is something more to look forward to when they finally leave and re-enter our community.

Ladies - Mark your calendars for Wednesday, April 4, 2018 to attend the SMWL membership meeting to vote

for the next 2-year grant recipient.

The committee has been working on evaluating the six applications that we received and have narrowed it down to the top three.

The night we meet, each applicant will have an opportunity to present what their organization is about, what they do, and why the need for funding from SMWL is needed for the next 2 years. Once the presentations are completed, the membership will make the final decision by selecting one of the top three.

If you won't be able to attend the meeting, you will be able to vote online by ballot. Your vote will be needed the day prior to the meeting. However, please try to attend as the presentations are so worthwhile. Sometimes we think we know everything an organization does and who they help, but until you hear it directly from the organization you really have no idea.

This only happens every two years, and to show your support to these groups by listening to their true need for support from SMWL, is necessary.

Once the applicant is selected, they will be notified that evening, the other two will also be told that they were not selected. The remaining three applicants will be informed prior to the presentations. Our President, Suzanne will then select two individuals to serve as liaisons to the organization, will meet with the winner and determine what are the immediate needs. This will be brought back to the Board, and they will vote to fund the first requirement.

It is a wonderful process, and I recommend that members sign up for this committee next time around, as it is so worthwhile.
