After coming up with some creative ideas for a fund-raising event and trying to choose dates, venues, etc. the group decided to put the breaks on this fund-raising event premise and take this time to really use this ad hoc committee in a bigger manner. Given that the initial objective from the Board was to have a 'solidified' idea by June 30th, they have decided to take a step back and regroup on researching/discovering where ALL of the sister members truly want to go with fund-raising and the Foundation and then work on the implementation of whatever the outcome of their research brings.

Recently, I ran into **Ray Swenton** and he asked me to share an update with everyone. You may remember, the SMWL gave awarded him a scholarship for two years at CSM.

Ray attended CSM from September 2016 to May 2019, where he earned a Transfer Certificate and an Associate Degree in Arts and Sciences. He had a GPA of 3.24 while working full-time.

Ray transferred to the University of Maryland, College Park, in September 2019 until his graduation in December 2021. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Information Science with GPA of 3.41. He was on the Dean's list Spring and Fall of both 2020 and 2021.

This past January, at the age of 40, he started his new career as a Junior Software Developer for Spalding Consulting, Inc., located in Lexington Park, Maryland.

## CSM Scholarship Committee Report

One of President Murphy's big initiatives is to award scholarships to as many of their returning students as possible to aid them in completing their studies. Therefore, CSM reviewed our recipients from last year and ALL six recipients were registered for Fall 2021 and had above a 3.0 GPA. Our MOU states, "The scholarship can be renewed for one consecutive academic year, providing the recipient remains in good academic standing."

The committee decided to waive the 'one' academic year for the four 2nd year students, returning for their third year... and agreed to award until they graduate. So, \$750.00 each was given to the four students who will be finishing in the 2021-2022 year; and for the two backups we had that received \$750.00 their first year, we also gave them \$750 for their second year. This was a unanimous decision.

The SMWL Scholarship Funds went to the following recipients:

- Alyssa Dorsey, 2020-21 2nd year recipient (1st year \$1,375; 2nd year \$750; 3rd year \$750)
- Maren Eels, 2020-21 2nd year recipient (1st year \$1,375; 2nd year \$750; 3rd year-\$750)
- Laura Phillips, 2020-21 2nd year recipient (1st year \$1,375; 2nd year \$750; 3rd year \$750)
- Courtney Romba, 2020-21 2nd year recipient (1st year \$1,375; 2nd year-\$750; 3rd year-\$750)
- Lindsay Bradburn 2020-21 1st year recipient (1st year \$750; 2nd year \$750)
- Michelle Metcalfe 2020-21 1st year recipient (1st year \$750; 2nd year \$750)

The SMWL Foundation requested that our Community Foundation annual distribution be the source of funds for our annual CSM Scholarship donation of \$3,000. The Check from the Community Foundation was issued and sent directly to CSM Foundation on November 12, 2021.

On Giving Tuesday, November 30, 2021 the SMWL Foundation was advertised as a Matching Donor up to our \$3,000 Limit. This just gives people a little more incentive to give to our scholarship... if they know that their donation is being matched (or doubled). As a result, the total raised for the SMWL Scholarship was \$3,795.00. The additional \$795.00 was comprised of 12 other donors... six of them SMWL Members and six other donors.

Additionally, in June of 2021, SMWL Foundation donated \$1,400 to start a scholarship at CSM in Donna Ellis' name since she served on the Scholarship Committee for years. The \$1,000 was from the SMWL Foundation and \$400 of it was from some of Donna's family's friends who wanted to donate to one of her charities as their expression of sympathy...and they chose SMWL Foundation. On Giving Tuesday, the Donna J. Ellis Memorial Scholarship had four donors...all four were SMWL members...and a total of \$550.00 was raised for the scholarship.

Donna's scholarship had a total of \$3,600. \$2,000 was awarded to Rachel Williamson for her Fall 2021 Semester and her Spring 2022 Semester. There is \$1,600 toward next year's scholarship. Stromie Ellis has agreed to write a check for the rest to make it \$2,000.00 for the next school year. Please note, the photo of Rachel Williamson and her Thank You Letter on the next page.
