



Welcome to our newest members... Kelly Jo Morgan Burch and Torri Turner! We have five others who have expressed interest and should be joining in the near future - we now have 48 members.

New Member Package with updated Membership Guidelines: When a potential new member sends in an application Brianna Bowling sends out the email for vote. Once approved Ann Seely sends the approved potential new member a welcome package that includes a dues invoice. Once dues are received, the welcome email is then sent to the membership as an announcement.

The original guidelines were outdated...so the Membership committee met and updated them...and this update includes pro-rated dues guidelines. Please note the updated guidelines below:

#### MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

Ladies must attend at least three functions of the SMWL general membership as a guest of a current member before being proposed for membership. After each general membership function, the Treasurer will report the names of attending guests to the Membership Committee Chair, who will keep a record of guests' attendance. Guests are welcome to any meetings of the SMWL. However, if guests attend the meeting where service projects are voted on; they will not be eligible/authorized to vote.

Guests are welcome to attend a minimum of three (3) functions (to include, but not limited to meetings) of the SMWL prior to joining, but can attend more than three. Guests are generally charged \$10.00 more for meetings or events than the published member price. Some exceptions apply: Members do not pay for the Christmas Party; as a portion of their dues pays for this. So, if a guest attends the Christmas Party, she will pay the full cost amount (typically...\$60). Other special events may be more expensive for guests. Members' dues subsidize all events/meeting expenses.

Applications for new members may be submitted after the individual has satisfied the three (3) meeting requirement and will be voted on via an email vote. The membership committee appointed person will email proposed members' name, photo and a brief bio to the full membership and allow three days for the membership to vote "Yea" or Nay". Any vote not received shall be considered affirmative. If four percent (4%) or more of the current members vote against a proposed new member, membership will not be offered (i.e. 2 votes out of 50 would be 4%). Once voted in, applicants will be considered full members upon remittance of dues.

All Members are required to participate in some way in SMWL's annual fundraiser.

All Members are also encouraged to join at least one committee and get to know other sisters and help to make the club a success

Annual dues are due to the League Treasurer by July 1st of each fiscal year. If a member pays their dues during the month of June before June 30th, they will receive a \$5.00 discount on the dues payment. New members joining between July and December will pay dues for the full year. New members joining between January and June will pay prorated dues of \$60.00flat fee. If the new member joins in May or June, it will be recommended that they wait and just pay the dues for the upcoming new Fiscal Year (due by July 1st) of \$160 or \$155 if paid before June 30th. In this case, for the months of May and June, she can attend events at the guest price.

Members who do not pay their dues in a timely manner will be removed from the membership directory, but may renew membership at any time by paying their full year's dues and any amounts outstanding such as dues, event fees, meals and other items. Past members that desire to rejoin SMWL may do so by paying the full current years' dues and any amounts owed to SMWL at the time of their departure.
