Net proceeds were \$30,000. Way to go ladies!

As the new Fiscal Year is now into its third month, we have been diligent about helping our project commitment and other 501(c)3 non-profits in their efforts to help women and children.

Angel's Watch: We provided the funds for a Moon Bounce for the Angel's Watch Children's Social and back-to-school event.

CSM Scholarships: a Committee comprised of Laura Brown, Sybil Alger and Lyn Bell reviewed all submitted applications and letters and chose three single mothers to receive \$500 each for each semester to utilize the \$3,000 in CSM Scholarship money we donated. I attended the Scholarship presentation ceremony, where one of the young women recipients told me how much she appreciated the funding and she has a special heart for our group. She wants to start a women's group similar to ours at the college.




SMWL EVENT RSVP PAYMENT REMINDER
