### It's hard to believe that my time as President has once again come to an end. It has truly been a pleasure to lead SMWL


through our 2015-2017 years. I was blessed to have two incredible boards with dedicated volunteers that were committed to making our club thrive. These

Dues are \$160.00 on and after July 1, 2017. Loving regards.


